
Resident Letter




Indoor Visitation

After the swim, residents will be able to enter the locker rooms from the pool area only to change out of their wet suit and into dry clothes before going home. Showers will not be available. Please continue to bring your own towels and wear your masks the entire time you are not in the pool.
