Dear Health Care Center Residents and Families:

Today, one resident who resides in the Health Care Center tested positive for COVID-19. The origin of the exposure is likely to be outside of CLV. All team members who work in that area have been tested. Residents who reside in the area where the positive test result was found were tested. In all cases, no other positive results have been found.

We continue to monitor all residents and team members for symptoms. Proper personal protective equipment continues to be worn and social distancing maintained. Group activities and group dining continue to be on hold for the next 10 – 14 days.

The following remains, unchanged:

- Visitors must remain masked the entire time in the facility, regardless of vaccination status.
- Visitors who are experiencing symptoms should refrain from visiting until symptoms are no longer present.
- When offered a test in our lobby, please consider doing so. We are at a heightened alert to mitigate further infections.

Visitors who do not have access to rapid tests can obtain a test from the concierge desk in 300 St. Luke Circle to self-test. All visitors must be masked during their entire visit with a loved one in the Health Care Center.

I will continue to provide updates on our outbreak status.
