Dear Health Care Center Residents and Families:

Yesterday, a Health Care Center resident tested positive for COVID-19. The origin of exposure was from a visiting family member. All team members who work in the area and residents who reside in the area have been tested. No additional positive results have been found.

The visiting family member was having cold symptoms. **Visitors should refrain from visiting if they are having any cold symptoms.** Visitors who accept our offer to test before coming to the Health Care Center ensure residents and team members will be in a safe environment when they visit.

All residents and team members continue to be monitored for symptoms. Proper personal protective equipment continues to be worn and social distancing maintained. Group activities and group dining continue to be on hold for the next 10 – 14 days.

The following remains, unchanged:

- Visitors must remain masked the entire time in the facility, regardless of vaccination status.
- Visitors who are experiencing symptoms should refrain from visiting until symptoms are no longer present.
- Visitors should permit testing when offered by our team to mitigate further infections during this heightened alert stage.

Visitors who do not have access to rapid tests can obtain a test from the concierge desk in 300 St. Luke Circle to self-test. All visitors must be masked during their entire visit with a loved one in the Health Care Center.

I will continue to provide updates on our outbreak status.
