SUBJECT: COVID-19 Update

Since the Dec. 12 COVID-19 update, our community's positive COVID-19 case count is:

- Independent living – 6
- Diven House – 13
- Health Care Center – 0

We are also seeing an increase in flu cases in both residents and team members. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention estimates there have been at least 13 million flu cases resulting in 120,000 hospitalizations with 7,300 deaths, so far.

To minimize the spread of COVID-19 and other respiratory illnesses this holiday season, hands should be washed or sanitized frequently and **masks need to be worn** until further notice in:

- Common areas
- Group activities
- Elevators
- Church services in Krug Chapel
- CLV shuttles

The **only exceptions** for wearing a mask are:

- Dining venues when food and beverages are being consumed

- Social events where food and beverages are being served
- Gym
- Pool

We will continue to monitor the number of positive cases and provide updates with any significant changes. Our goal is to provide the safest environment for all during this holiday season.

Visitors

All visitors need to wear a mask in all common areas and hallways throughout the entire campus. Visitors who are experiencing influenza or COVID-19-like symptoms should visit at another time. We appreciate our visitors' efforts to keep our community safe.
